FALL GRAND CHEMINOT, OCTOBER 3, 2009 Howard Johnson Plaza Hotel, Kansas City, Missouri

With a rap of the gavel, Grand Chef de Gare, Gary L. Reno, opened the Fall Grand Cheminot sharply at 1:02 PM with a salute to the Flag, the Pledge of Allegiance, and a much needed prayer by Grand Aumonier, Marvin Harper.

Roll call of officers showed more absent than excused and the rest were being a pain in the rear. Roll call of Grand Chefs de Gare Passe showed that nine-answered. Roll call of Grand Cheminots showed that we had a quorum. Voyageurs don't know how to answer roll call and many paid fines for it. Absent were Voitures 293, 333, 447, 460,520, 966, and 1395.

Grant Willis gave the Rules of Procedure. Notion offered by Virgil Morice, seconded by Robert Phillips, that the Grand Promenade and Cheminot minutes are accepted as printed and sent out...passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning gave the minutes of the Executive Meeting. The Executive Meeting was held on October 3, 2009 starting at 9:06am. The budget was read and Dave Christian made a motion to approve, 2^{nd} by Don Fligge...passed. Discussion was held about the next raffle. It will go out in January 2010. It was suggested extra raffle tickets be sent to the Locale Chef or Correspondant to sell. After discussion Terry Lanning offered a notion to accept the raffle letter after a reduction of prize money to be \$250, \$150, and \$50, 2^{nd} by Chubbs Buckley ...passed. Discussion was held on the minimum qualifications to be Grand Chef de Gare. They are:

- Must have been in the 40/8 for at least 5 years.
- Must have been nominated by your Locale Voiture and have served as your Locale Voiture's Chef de Gare.
- Must have served as a Grand Sous Grand Chef de Train.
- Must have served as a Grand Directeur or in a comparable Grande Officer position.
- Must have demonstrated the ability to be a leader in your Locale and/or Grand du Missouri.
- Must have the time, ability, and means to be Grand Chef de Gare. Terry Lanning offer a motion to accept the minimum qualifications to be Grand Chef de Gare, 2nd by Chubbs Buckley ... passed. Terry Lanning explained Voiture 848 had sent in a resolution stating they wanted to dissolve. The Grande Executive Committee was polled and they agreed to accept Voiture 848 resolution to dissolve. Notice was sent to Voiture National and the dissolution of Voiture 848 was accepted at Promenade Nationale. Terry sent a letter to the members of Voiture 848 asking them to transfer. Executive meeting closed 9:41am. Grant offered a notion to accept 2nd by Robert Phillips ... passed.

Grand Correspondant Terry Lanning told everyone that the new yearbooks and envelopes for the Grand Directeurs are in the back of the room. Next years La Petite will not be mailed out but can be obtained from the 40/8 web site.

Grand Commissaire Intendant, David Christian, reported that the finance report was placed on the chairs and asked if there were any questions. Notion offered by Grant Willis, second by Robert Phillips, to approve the budget and accept the Finance report subject to audit... passed.

Grand Chef de Train, Larry Ebersold, reported on the current Grande membership. The Grande has 416 members, 35%. There is one Voiture that have not turned in any membership. Larry asked the Sous Chef de Trains to report to which Robert Fletcher, Chip Berkley, and John Paul Kopp reported on the Voitures they are assigned. Chef Gary Reno presented last years Grand Chef Robert Phillips with the three awards that Missouri won at Promenade Nationale.

Cheminot Nationale Grant Willis reported on the Nationale Promenade. Grant attended the Child Welfare meeting and they said the Ardery claims are not being sent in correct. There is a new password. Chubbs Buckley went to the Nurses Training meeting and stated there were 23 Boland scholarships approved. Terry Lanning attended the Finance Meeting and stated the finances are in pretty good shape. No talk of a dues increase. Gerald Brady was elected Chef de Chemin de Fer, he is out of Texas. Tony Gallagher was appointed as the National Public Relations Directeur and Terry Lanning was elected Commissaire Intendant National. Voiture 333 won three awards.

2010 - September 8 to 11 at Springfield, Illinois

2011 - September 7 to 10 at Vancouver, Washington

2012 - September 12 to 15 at Northern, Kentucky

Grand Cheminot reports were given by Voiture 3, 38, 130, 292, 448, 760, 1292, 1321, 1379, 1402, 1403, and 1541. Some of the highlights are Voiture 3 budgeted \$30,000 for their programs and budgeted \$21,000 for nurses training; Voiture 38 had 250 special kids at Grants Farm; Voiture 130 has 14 nurses in training, they are selling towels to fund their nurses training, Washington's Birthday Party (next year it will be 2/13/2010); Voiture 292 has 12 nurses and looking for 8 more, they had a patient jamboree at the VA Hospital; Voiture 448 had its installation of officers; Voiture 760 made some donations; Voiture 1292 has 7 nurses, a Christmas party for special kids will be 12/8/09; Voiture 1321 has 5 nurses and their cooker is out, their xmas party will be 12/20/09; Voiture 1379 had their ChicNic in September, has 1 nurse but is looking for two more; Voiture 1402 has 2 nurses and is looking for 2 more; Voiture 1403 had a successful BBQ, 4 nurses and will have a xmas party; Voiture 1541 has 5 nurses in training.

Grand Historien, John Paul said history is a go.

Grand Aumonier Marvin Harper says God bless everyone.

Grand Conducteur Robert Emery says he was collecting fines and selling pins.

Grand Directeur Box Car, Bill Evans, stated he only has Box Car pins left for \$3.00 each. If anyone needs any pins to let him know. All Box Car money for pins, cards, or donations should be sent to him with the report form filled out.

Grand Directeur POW/MIA, Dave Diaz, sent in his report. The POW/MIA issue will always remain as long as we have troops stationed in harms way. As of now the most important legislation is House Resolution #111. What this means is to establish a select committee on POW/MIA affairs. This resolution will insure that the government will never stop searching for POW/MIA comrades. He encourages all voyageurs to contact their US Rep and encourage them to support this action.

Grand Directeur Ritual, John Partin, stated the new ritual books are out and you can obtain them from Voiture Nationale. Every Locale should have one.

Sous Correspondant, Grant Willis, said to send him any articles and flyers to be put in the Grand Newsletter.

Time & Place Committee, Robert Eisenbath, reported that the Spring Grande Wreck and Cheminot would be in Jefferson City, at the Truman Hotel (room rate \$55.00), on March 26-28, 2010. Spring Wreck Banquet will cost \$25.00 with a registration fee of \$10.00. Grande Promenade (June 25 to 27, 2010) and the Fall Grand Cheminot & Homecoming (October 1 to 3, 2010) will also be held there. The Grand Promenade and Homecoming registration fee will be \$5.00.

Grand Chef de Gare Reno spoke on the Central States Promenade. In 2011 it will be held in Missouri. Friday their was a meeting on the Central States.



Membership is coming in very close to what it did last year, but we should see some radical improvements over the next couple of months.
